Minutes of the 11th Goa State Expert Appraisal Committee (Goa-SEAC) meeting held on 11th January 2013 at 10.00 a.m. in the Conference Room of the EIA Secretariat, O/o Goa State Pollution Control Board (GSPCB), Patto.

The eleventh meeting of the Goa-SEAC was held on 11^{th} January 2013 in the Conference room of the GSPCB under the Chairmanship of Dr. S. P. Fondekar. The list of members who attended the meeting is at "Annexure – 1".

At the outset, Chairman welcomed the members and subsequently, Dr. Mohan R. Girap, Secretary, SEAC appraised the members about the purpose of the meeting and presented the Agenda items ($\underline{\text{Annexure}} - \underline{2}$) to the Members. Accordingly, the item-wise proposals were discussed / deliberated with suitable recommendations, as applicable.

Project-wise comments are listed as under:-.

- 1. Following project proposals which were forwarded by the O/o the Goa Coastal Zone Management Authority (GCZMA) were appraised in order to ascertain the applicability of the EIA Notification, 2006:
 - a. Mr. Arun Naik, PAH for Mr. Arun Shah, H. No. 10, Gaint, Bogmolo, Goaproposed construction of Arun resort (68 rooms) in Survey No. 63/3 of Chicalim village, Mormugao taluka in South Goa district.

The proposed site is categorized under CRZ-III zone (open land under settlement zone) and located beyond 200 mts. from HTL covering total plot area of 9,159 sq.mts. The proposed resort construction (68 rooms) involves <u>built-up</u> area of 2,922.64 sq.mts. As such, the proposed construction activity requires NOC from the MoEF / NCZMA, subject to suitable recommendation from the Goa Coastal Zone Management Authority (GCZMA) as per CRZ Notification, 2011. Further, the said activity needs to be complied with the "Policy for utilization of available open plots in CRZ-III zone" issued by the Department of Science, Technology & Environment (DST&E) vide letter no. GCZMA/H. COURT MATTER/07/656/Part IV/311 dated 10th June 2011.

Based on the proposed built-up area involved and as per the 'Schedule' annexed to the EIA Notification, 2006, the said construction activity does not come under the purview of the said Notification as the proposed total built-up area is less than 20,000 sq. mts.

- 2. Subsequently, following two (02) developmental proposals (*refer Annexure-2*) were discussed after their project presentations by respective project proponents / environmental consultants concerned.
 - a. Proposed construction of Group Housing and commercial project (i.e. 400 flats and 52 commercial shops of 609 sq.mts. each.) in Survey no. 20/3-A of Bainguinim village of Tiswadi taluka in North Goa district by Mr. Rajendra Prasad Singla, Margao, Goa.
 - b. Proposed construction of Eco-resort (i.e. 1 restaurant 572 seats and 16 building clusters (i.e. G + 2) with 200 rooms) in Survey no. 16 & 7 of Moitem village in Bardez taluka of North Goa district by M/s Mahindra and Mahindra Ltd., Chennai.

For the above projects, the Committee sought additional information / details pertaining to –

- 1. <u>Rainwater harvesting initiatives and/or water conservations measures</u> (i.e. proposed underground storage) with relevant technical details along with site-specific plans/drawings.
- 2. <u>Plan of action towards optimum utilization of natural resources</u> (i.e. sunlight) with special reference to energy conservation in service utility areas / landscape development.
- 3. <u>Monitoring mechanism of groundwater</u> (i.e. bore well / open well) / <u>surface sources</u> (i.e. river, canal, lake, etc.,) existing within as well as around periphery of the proposed site, if any, to understand water quality and decipher possible impacts, if any.
- 4. Existing land-use / land-cover within 5 kms. around the periphery of the propose project site so as to understand the presence of ecologically sensitive areas. If any.

Further and based on the site-inspection conducted subsequently on 22nd and 24th January 2013, the Committee has decided to recommend these projects to the Authority for issuance of prior EC as mandated in the EIA Notification, 2006.

3. Later, following proposals for carrying out extraction of minor minerals (renewal of lease), as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court "Order" issued dated 27th February 2012 in a matter S. L. P. (c) No. 19628 – 19628 of 2009 and in response to 'Official Memorandum' issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests (MoEF), Govt. of India, as well as 'Order' issued by the Directorate of Mines and Geology, Govt. of Goa. were taken up for discussion / deliberation subsequent to project presentation by respective Project Proponent (PP) / environmental consultant. The respective quarry sites were also inspected on 24th and 25th January 2013 to ascertain on-site status visa-vis field observations. Project details may please be referred from *Annexure-2*.

- **A.** M/s Sapna Ceramics Pvt. Ltd., The Project Proponent (PP) has proposed to renew following three (03) existing "Basalt stone" quarry leases namely
 - (i) Lease no. 10/basalt/93 10,000 sq.mts. (valid upto 22^{nd} June 2013)
 - (ii) Lease no. 03/Basalt/94 29,225 sq.mts. (valid upto 22nd June 2014)
 - (iii) Lease no. 2/Basalt/98 22,000 sq.mts. (*valid upto 18th February 2013*)

In addition, it has proposed <u>One New Lease</u> covering total area of 50,000 sq.mts. which is in continuous with the existing leases and located in Survey No. 29/1, of village Conquerim in Sattari taluka of North Goa district.

Further, another old lease, existing within the plot area, bearing no. 01/Basalt/07 – 19,000 sq.mts. has been closed and surrendered to the Directorate of Mines and Geology (DMG), Goa in February 2012.

- **B.** Mr. Vinayak Vasudev Chodankar The PP has proposed to renew the existing "Basalt stone" quarry leases bearing lease no. 01/Basalt/97 which is located in Survey No, 63/1 of village Santona in Sanguem taluka of South Goa district. The lease validity of which has expired in January 2007.
- C. M/s Bomba Laterite Stones The PP has proposed to renew following three (03) "Laterite stone" quarry lease located in Survey Nos. 58/0 (2.8650 ha.), 52/1&2 (4.26 ha.) and 56/0 (3.2275 ha.) in Loutolim village in Salcete taluka of South Goa district namely
 - (i) 02/Laterite/88 2.6424 ha. (*valid upto February 2013*)
 - (ii) 03/Laterite/03 2.35 ha. (*valid upto May 2013*)
 - (iii) 06/Laterite/07 2.9886 ha. (*lease expired in July 2012*)

Subsequently, based on the project presentation as well as well on-site clarification during the inspection vis-a-vis submission of additional details from respective PPs', the Committee decided to recommend these proposals to the Authority for issuance of prior EC as mandated in the EIA Notification, 2006 subject to monitoring and compliance to the following by the Directorate of Mines and Geology (DMG), namely –

- a. 'Goa Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2012 notified by the Directorate of Mines and Geology (DMG) and published in Official Gazette Series-I, No. 24 dated 17th September 2012.
- b. Submission of 'approved quarrying plan' by the competent officer as per Subrule (7) as well as specific compliance to Sub-rules 7(A) to 7(D) of the above-referred Rules, as applicable.
- c. Ascertaining the compliance to "Order" issued by National Green Tribunal (NGT) dated 21st September 2012 in a matter related to Review Application no.

8/2012 in Application No. 26/2012 and verifying that the minor minerals lease areas referred in (A), (B) and (C) above do not fall within the Ecologically Sensitive Zone (ESZ-1) as defined in the Western Ghats Ecology Expert Panel (WGEEP) report.
