Minutes of the 14th Goa State Expert Appraisal Committee (Goa-SEAC) meeting held on 8th April 2013 at 10.00 a.m. in the Conference Room of the EIA Secretariat, O/o Goa State Pollution Control Board (GSPCB), Patto.

The fourteenth meeting of the Goa-SEAC was held on 8^{th} April 2013 in the Conference room of the GSPCB under the Chairmanship of Dr. S. P. Fondekar. The list of members who attended the meeting is at "<u>Annexure – 1</u>".

At the outset, Chairman welcomed the members and subsequently, Dr. Mohan R. Girap, Secretary, SEAC appraised the members about the purpose of the meeting and presented the Agenda items (<u>Annexure – 2</u>) to the Members. Accordingly, the item-wise proposals were discussed / deliberated with suitable recommendations, as applicable.

Project-wise comments are listed as under:-.

- 1. Reconsideration of following deferred proposal for minor mineral quarry leases by
 - a. **M/s Joao Lourenco Baptista** for <u>Renewal</u> of two 'Basalt stone quarries' (*lease nos. (i)* 01/Basalt/04 Lease area 7,150 sq.mts. and 04/Basalt/04 Lease area 5,080 sq.mts.) located in survey no. 52/0 of Uguem village of Sanguem taluka in South Goa district.

Comments – Subsequent to project as well as site-specific compliance submitted by the Project Proponent (PP) and its scrutiny, the <u>Committee has decided to recommend the</u> <u>proposal subject to mandatory compliance</u> to the outcome by the PP after ascertaining current status, to be verified, by the Directorate of Mines and Geology (DMG), Goa in respect of –

- 1. Decision / order issued in respect of the PIL Writ Petition No. 10/2012. (*Francis Xavier Carvalho V/s Dept. of Mines and Geology*) and
- 2. 'Suspension order cum Show Cause Notice' issued by the DMG dated 8th October 2012.
- b. M/s Rumaldo Fernandes for <u>New</u> 'Laterite stone quarry' located in survey no. 42/0 (*lease area 7,180 sq.mts.*) of Muguli village in Sanguem taluka of South Goa district.

Comments – <u>The Committee decided to defer the proposal</u> as the proponent has not yet complied with / submitted the project-cum-site-specific observations.

2. Scrutiny and appraisal of the following new proposals namely -

a. M/s Mario Mascarenhas – for <u>Renewal-cum-expansion</u> of 'Basalt stone quarry' located in Survey no. 62/1 (*Lease area - 7,000 sq.mts.*) of Santona village in Sanguem taluka of South Goa district.

Comments – <u>The Committee</u>, subsequent to project presentation by the proponent and detailed deliberation followed by site inspection on 9^{th} April 2013 and ascertaining on-site clarification, has decided to <u>recommend the proposal</u>.

b. **M/s Nilu Jaidev Shetye** – for <u>New</u> 'Laterite stone quarry' located in Survey no. 24/1 (*Lease area – 2,000 sq.mts.*) of Menkurem village in Bicholim taluka of North Goa district.

Comments - <u>The Committee</u>, subsequent to project presentation by the proponent and detailed deliberation, has decided to <u>recommend the proposal</u>.

c. M/s Anil Shaba Fal Dessai – for <u>New</u> 'Basalt stone quarry' located in survey no. Survey no. 19/1(P) – Lease area – 4,000 sq.mts. of Goculdem village in Quepem taluka of South Goa district.

Comments - <u>The Committee</u>, subsequent to project presentation by the proponent and detailed deliberation, has <u>decided to reserve its decision pending site-inspection</u>. However, suggested that Authority may take a suitable decision after inspection, if agreeable.

d. **M/s Kaloshi Granites** – for <u>Renewal</u> of 'Basalt stone quarry' located in survey no. Survey no. 12/1 of Damochem village in Sattari taluka of North Goa district.

Comments – <u>The Committee reserved its decision</u> as the said proposal could neither be discussed in detail nor site-inspection be conducted, owing to last-minute submission. However, it was suggested that Authority may take a suitable decision after its inspection, if agreeable.

Accordingly, the Committee has recommended the proposals mentioned in 1(a) and 2(a) and (b) above with a request to undertake monitoring and compliance to the following by the Directorate of Mines and Geology (DMG), namely –

- a. 'Goa Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2012 notified by the Directorate of Mines and Geology (DMG) and published in Official Gazette Series-I, No. 24 dated 17th September 2012.
- b. Submission of **'approved quarrying plan'** by the competent officer as per Subrule (7) as well as specific compliance to Sub-rules 7(A) to 7(D) of the abovereferred Rules, as applicable.

c. Ascertaining the compliance to "Order" issued by National Green Tribunal (NGT) dated 21st September 2012 in a matter related to Review Application no. 8/2012 in Application No. 26/2012 and verifying that the minor minerals lease areas referred above do not fall within the Ecologically Sensitive Zone (ESZ-1) as defined in the Western Ghats Ecology Expert Panel (WGEEP) report.

While, the Committee deferred the proposal mentioned in 1(b) and reserved its decision pertaining to proposals mentioned in 2 (c) and (d) with a request that Authority to take suitable decision in these matters.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
