

**Minutes of the 67<sup>th</sup> Goa State Expert Appraisal Committee  
(Goa-SEAC) meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2016 at 3.00 p.m. in the Conference  
Room of the Goa State Pollution Control Board (GSPCB), Patto.**

The sixty-seven meeting of the Goa-SEAC was held on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2016 in the Conference room of the GSPCB from 03.00 p.m. onwards under the Chairmanship of Mr. Antonio Jaime Afonso. The list of members who attended the meeting is at “Annexure – I”.

At the outset, Chairman welcomed the Members and requested Secretary, SEAC to proceed as per the Agenda items (refer Annexure – 2). Subsequently, post-inspection submission dated 25<sup>th</sup> May 2016 made by **M/s Mahadhan Real Estate LLP, Vasco-da-Gama** was perused / ascertained / verified by the Committee in response to the observations deliberated and committee noted that during the re-inspection, the Committee observed that the nallah depicted on the survey plan was found to be clogged with construction debris / vegetation and has compromised drainage capacity. Considering the likelihood of inundation in the event of high precipitation as also due to high water table and hydric nature of the soil as well as proposed land-filling of low-lying area within the proposed plot, it is strongly recommended that the PP takes adequate mitigative measures prior to commencement / during as well as post-construction phases. This is with specific reference to (a) inundation of the main road, (b) water logging in the adjoining agricultural fields and (c) stagnation of water leading to public health hazards. Accordingly, the onus of ensuring a smooth drainage of storm water through the nallah as proposed shall entirely lie with the PP during pre-construction / construction / post-construction phases. As such, the Committee recommends the proposal with observation as above.

Later, Proposal submitted by **M/s Gera Developments Pvt. Ltd.**, seeking prior environmental clearance (EC) for construction of premium housing and commercial development ‘*Enchanted woods*’ at survey no.33/1, Candola village, Ponda, Goa was discussed and deliberate, committee noted that the proposal be kept in abeyance till receipt of compliance upto 20<sup>th</sup> June 2016, beyond which the project would be recommended for delisting. However, the Committee requested the Chairman, SEAC to invite the representatives of **Betqi-Khandola Samvardhan Samittee** (*President - Mr. Arun Mangaonkar*) and **Shantadurga Devlay**

**Residents Association Khandola, Marcela** (*President – Salvador Dias and Secretary – K.S. Gaonkar*) in the next SEAC meeting, if need be.

Further, proposal received from the **Department of Science & Technology (DST)** seeking Terms of References (ToRs) for setting up of a common Bio-medical Waste Treatment Facility at Kundaim Industrial Estate was perused and also proposal received from **M/s Mahadhan Real Estate LLP, Vasco-da-Gama** for construction activity proposed at **Chimbel, Tiswadi taluka, North Goa**. Committee decided to inspect the both sites on **9<sup>th</sup> June 2016**.

As directed by the Authority during its 30<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2016, to carry out Joint inspection by committee members to **M/s Aakar Creations Pvt. Ltd., Vanelim, Margao, Goa** along with Project Proponent and complainant. The Committee inspected the site on 26<sup>th</sup> May 2016 and after discussion with the Complainant and the Project Proponent (PP), it was noted that the complaint pertains to issuance of post-facto EC by the Goa-SEIAA to **M/s Aakar Creations Pvt. Ltd., Margao** in response to the ‘Order’ pronounced by the NGT dated **7<sup>th</sup> July 2015** w.r.t issuance of post-facto EC.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
