Minutes of the 17th meeting of Goa State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (Goa-SEIAA) held on 5th December 2014 at 12.00 p.m. in the Conference room of the EIA Secretariat, O/o Goa State Pollution Control Board (GSPCB), Patto.

The seventeenth meeting of the Goa-SEIAA was held on 5th December 2014 in the Conference room of the GSPCB under the Chairmanship of Dr. Pramod Pathak. The list of members is annexed (*refer <u>Annexure – 1</u>*).

At the outset, Chairman welcomed the members and informed about the purpose of convening the meeting to consider Goa-SEAC's recommendations and finalize the decision for grant of prior environmental clearance (EC) to project proposals as listed in the agenda items (*refer <u>Annexure – 2</u>*).

Accordingly and on perusal of SEAC's recommendations vis-a-vis verification of compliances submitted by respective project proponents (PPs'), project-specific observations by the Authority are as under –

 Proposed establishment of Solid Waste Management Facility (SWMF) at Cacora in South Goa submitted by the Department of Science, Technology and Environment (DST&E), Saligao vide letter no. 3-209-2014/STE-DIR/Part-16B/SWMC-17 dated 28th November 2014.

The Authority has considered and accepted SEAC's recommendations and accordingly decided to grant prior environmental clearance (EC) to the project.

2. Proposed development of residential complex in land bearing P.T. Sheet no. 121 & Chalta No. 2,3,4,38,39 & P.T. Sheet No. 130 & Chalta no. 33 of St. Inez village, Tiswadi Taluka by **M/s Marvel Resorts Pvt. Ltd., Panaji.**

The Authority has noted that –

- a. PP has to make a provision for storm water drainage into the existing nallah into downstream of the existing bridge. Discharge pipes should be laid down cutting across the road sufficiently on the way from the connecting bridge ensuring no harm to the old bridge. Accordingly, a detailed diagram / lay out plan need to be re-submitted.
- b. PP should specify whether stored water for non-potable use will be lifted from underground pit or there is a separate storage tank.
- c. In addition, should specify storm water quantity proposed to be discharged considering heavily raining days with maximum rains and justify through calculations that it would not result in flooding within the proposed plot.
- d. Total rain water harvesting potential as estimated for 90 days needs to be revised considering its practical feasibility. Further, PP may clarify at what rate of rainfall in a day, quantity of 205 KLD per day fresh water will be harvested. Accordingly, harvested water quantity, meeting 100% water

utilization, needs to be justified as the proposed quantity appears to be unrealistic.

- e. PP should ensure that material transport during non-peak hrs should exclude transportation from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. in order avoid nuisance to local residents staying within the close proximity to the proposed site.
- f. After finalising the 8-storey building design and the columns supporting the building, dimensional design should justify load bearing capacity. The designer / architect should furnish details of the ground resistance to the loading columns for verification because slight tilting of the building in any event due to inadequate load bearing capacity will be detrimental to the building. Accordingly, PP should specify any strong measures been taken against sinking of the load bearing columns.

And decided to consider the proposal subsequent to receival of compliance to (a) to (e) above.

Subsequently, the Authority while considering the following proposals namely,

- (i) M/s Counto Metals & Mining Co. Ltd., Panaji for proposed expansion of twin jetty with common deck in Tixem, Cottombi village, Bicholim taluka, North Goa.
- (ii) M/s Kamat Real Estate Developers, Panaji for proposed residential-cum-commercial complex at Caranzalem, Tiswadi taluka, North Goa.
- (iii) M/s Devashri Real Estate Developers, Panaji for proposed residential complex at Socorro, Bardez taluka, North Goa.

decided to verify the compliances submitted by the respective project proponents (PPS') visa-vis SEAC's recommendations prior to decide further course of action. While, in respect of a proposal submitted by **M/s Raheja Universal (Pvt.) Ltd.,** Mumbai - for proposed residential complex in village Carmona, Salcet taluka, South Goa district, the Authority decided to conduct independent site-inspection of the proposed site at Carmona for further decision in the matter.

Meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair.
